Important Requirements

Each student must have a U.S. Coast Guard approved type III life jacket, (bring your own or NCCS will provide); rubber soled closed toe shoes; sunscreen and a water bottle. Also, students must be able to swim 50 yards. Medical and waiver forms must be signed prior to the start of classes.

Send your registration and fee early, space is limited and fills quickly.

Need based Scholarships are available, please ask if interested.

Optional annual memberships help sustain the program and offer a place where people can access the water and sailing for a nominal fee.
